



## GRESHAM'S SCHOOL – GIRLS' CLOTHING LIST

Minimum Requirements for Girl Boarders

The School Shop is the exclusive stockist of the School blazer, the tartan skirts and the white shirt, and can supply most of the other items listed. Day girls can manage with fewer of the items listed, at parents' discretion.

### Fifth Form and below

- 1 **Name Tapes** – Standard tapes, **12 dozen (2 dozen should be passed onto House Matron)**. These may be ordered from the School Shop. Large tapes **12mm (1/2")**, minimum of **3 dozen sewn onto games kit (as directed on attached diagram)** and towels. These large tapes may be ordered from [www.jjcash.co.uk](http://www.jjcash.co.uk) – **Style 17**. All tapes should have House initial after name.
- 2 **1 School blazer**
- 3 **2 Tartan skirts**
- 4 **3 navy crew-necked long sleeved medium weight sweaters. plain finish – not heavy ribbed or patterned. Please purchase from the School Shop.**
- 5 **6 School shirts**
- 6 **2 pairs black leather shoes, polishable (not boots, not suede, not mules), flat to medium heel**
- 7 **1 School scarf (optional)**
- 8 **1 overcoat (in plain black or navy, long enough to cover jackets or blazers worn underneath).**
- 9 **12 pairs tights in navy/black**
- 10 **Sports bra – essential (high impact grade)**
- 11 **2 nightdresses/pyjamas**
- 12 **1 dressing gown (essential)**
- 13 **1 pair slippers**
- 14 **4 medium sized bath towels (with loop half way down one of the long sides)**
- 15 **1 sponge bag, washing kit and clothes brush**
- 16 **1 hairbrush and comb**
- 17 **Casual clothes and underwear (all clearly marked)**

### Sixth Form

**Item 1 and items 10 – 17 above, plus:**

- 18 **A sober classic tailored suit in black, charcoal grey or navy. Jacket length must be below hip level to cover any shirt/blouse/sweater worn, and can be worn with either skirt or trousers. Skirts should allow for easy movement and be cut to sit at waist level and of a length that touches the knee to mid calf. Trousers, also cut to sit at waist, should be of a classic tailored fit and of an appropriate length for school footwear. Stretch fabrics, linen or denim are not suitable and the suit should be of a generous cut. Small check or pinstripe is acceptable.**
- 19 **White blouses/shirts with collar**
- 20 **Black, brown or navy polishable shoes (not boots, not suede, not mules,**

- flat to medium heels)**
- 21 Round or V-neck long sleeved pullovers, plain colour and finish of own choice, of sufficient length to cover the blouse/shirt (not cardigans)**
  - 22 Sober coloured tights**
  - 23 1 Sixth form scarf (optional)**

**Casual clothes, clearly marked, may be worn at certain times.**

**Below is a compulsory list for Third, Fourth and Fifth formers, who will follow a programme which includes hockey, netball, swimming, tennis, athletics and rounders. Opportunities to play badminton and squash are also available.**

Sixth formers will opt for activities from a list including those in the above programme and will need games clothes for their options. Requirements therefore vary and you should consult your Housemistress if in doubt.

### **Miscellaneous**

- 42 1 trunk or large suitcase
- 43 1 padlock (spare key to be handed to House Matron)
- 44 1 small lockable storage container to keep items of value (tuck box)
- 45 1 briefcase or bag (obligatory below Sixth Form)
- 46 1 sports/overnight type bag
- 47 1 dictionary

1 calculator (this is supplied only by our Maths Department; new pupils are issued with the correct calculator at the start of their first term.

House Colours – Polo Shirt to be purchased from Housemistress during Term.

### **IMPORTANT**

Please ensure that **ALL** items are named, including casual clothes, boots, shoes and luggage. Ensure that **ALL** items of clothing can be machine washed and tumble dried. It is recommended that expensive laptops, watches, pens etc, should be engraved with their owner's name. It is recommended that girls who wear glasses bring a spare pair. No make up below the 6<sup>th</sup> form.
