Girls’ Games Kit

Below is a compulsory list for Years 9 – 11, who will follow a programme which includes hockey, netball, swimming, tennis, athletics and rounders. Opportunities to play badminton and squash are also available.

Games kit should have external name tapes sewn on as shown in the accompanying labelling guide. Size 12mm or 15mm labels are recommended and can be ordered from www.wovina.com or from www.jjcash.co.uk.

- 1 Black School ¼ zip fleece
- 1 Black School rain jacket
- 2 Pairs black School training pants
- 1 Black & white Canterbury games shirt
- 1 Black School games skort (for winter)
- 1 White School games skort (for summer)
- 1 Black School base layer top
- 1 Pair Black School base layer bottoms
- 2 Pairs white ankle socks
- 1 School athletics vest
- 1 White School polo shirt (compulsory for Year 9 PE & those studying GCSE PE)
- 2 Pairs black & white School games socks
- 1 Pair training shoes (non-marking soles) (not available from Schoolblazer)
- 1 Pair Astro shoes (not available from Schoolblazer)
- 1 Pair running spikes (optional)(not available from Schoolblazer)
- 1 One-piece School swimming costume (black or navy)
- 1 Sports towel (not available from Schoolblazer)
- 1 School sports bag
- 1 Hockey stick (not available from Schoolblazer)
- 1 Tennis racket (not available from Schoolblazer)
- A Sports bra is essential for all girls regardless of bust size, and along with current medical advice, we strongly recommend a properly fitted, cupped sports bra (not ‘crop-top’ style) (not available from Schoolblazer). All sports played at Gresham’s: netball, tennis, running, aerobics and hockey are considered to be “high impact”. The appropriate level of support and a good fit are essential. Marks and Spencers™, for example, do a range of sports bras and the website www.lessbounce.com will recommend a suitable bra according to size and level of activity.

Please ensure that **ALL** items of clothing can be machine washed and tumble dried.

It is recommended that any expensive laptops, watches, pens, etc., should be engraved with their owner's name.

It is recommended that girls who wear glasses bring a spare pair.

Please note: No make-up below the Sixth Form.
