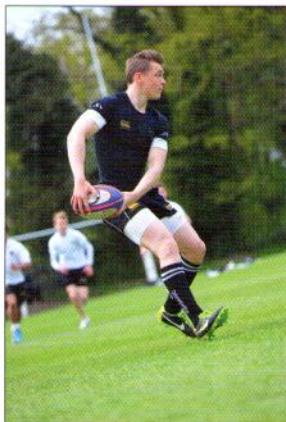

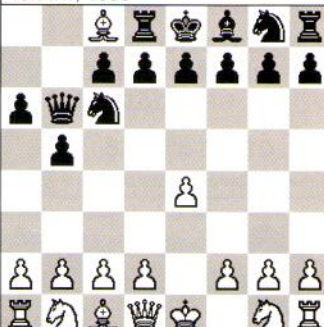
CHESS PROBLEMS by Dr Cedric Lytton

Solution to No.179: 1.d4 Nf6 2.Bh6 gxf6 3.g4 h5 4.g5 Bh6
 5.g6 0-0 6.g7 Bc1! 7.gxf8B Kh8 8.Bh6 Ng8 9.Bxc1. This manoeuvre,
 whereby a promoted P returns to the home square of a similar
 captured piece, is the Phoenix theme (obvious derivation). Black's
 6th move is the only waiting move that doesn't otherwise disturb the
 position, and so we see the newly-promoted white B following its
 opposite number all the way from base to base.
 More B shenanigans in No.180 which may remind readers of a
 "kissing-gate". Hint: the visible necessary black moves take up all
 6 allowed by the stipulation, so the missing black B died at home.
