### Years 9 – 11

- Name tapes – All items of clothing must be clearly labelled with pupil's surname, initial and House initial.

**All tapes should have the House first initial after a student's name  
e.g. J SMITH F (house initials are Q, E, F, H, O, T or W)**

Please contact the School Shop if you need help with labels as they have details of a local seamstress who may be able to provide a chargeable service.

- 1 School tweed jacket
  - 2 School ties
  - 2 School V- neck jumpers
  - 2 Pairs black leather shoes (**not** boots, **not** suede, **not** buckled)
  - 1 Coat, which must be smart enough to look appropriate when covering a suit or blazer. Long enough to cover the blazer or jacket of a suit. Plain navy, black or charcoal grey - not puffas, anoraks, or with fur on hood.
  - 3 Pairs charcoal grey trousers (formal style worsted-type material)
  - 6 Cotton chambray shirts
  - Grey ankle socks
  - School scarf (optional)
  - Black woollen gloves (optional)
- For Boarders only:**
- 1 Dressing gown
  - 1 Pair slippers
  - 3 Medium sized bath towels (with loop half way down one of the long sides)
  - Washing kit and flannels
  - Casual clothes (e.g. jeans, T-shirts, sweatshirts) all clearly marked

**Sixth Form (Years 12-13)** (School Colours do not supply Sixth Form dress)

- Name Tapes – as above.  
**All tapes should have House initials after student's name.**
- 2 Traditional plain suits (black, charcoal grey or navy blue). Subtle check or pinstripe is acceptable.
- 2 Pairs of polishable black or brown shoes (**not** boots, **not** suede, **not** buckled)
- 2 V-neck jumpers, plain colour/plain finish of own choice (**no** cardigans, **no** polo or crew necks)
- Ties of own choice and 1 School tie
- White shirts
- Charcoal grey socks
- 1 Coat, which must be smart enough to look appropriate when covering a suit or blazer. Long enough to cover the blazer or jacket of a suit. Plain navy, black or charcoal grey - not puffas, anoraks, or with fur on hood.  
**For Boarders only:**
- 1 Dressing gown
- 1 Pair slippers
- 3 Medium sized bath towels (with loop half way down one of the long sides)
- Washing kit
- Casual clothes (e.g. jeans, T-shirts, sweatshirts, all clearly marked)

**Sixth Form attire can be purchased from any suitable outfitters but must be as described above. There are well-defined dress regulations. If in doubt about the acceptability of any item, please consult your Housemaster.**
