### Year 9 – 11

- Name tapes – All items of clothing must be clearly labelled with pupil's surname, initial and House initial.

**All tapes should have the House first initial after a student's name  
e.g. J SMITH Q (house initials are Q, E, F, H, O, T or W)**

Please contact the School Shop if you need help with labels as they have details of a local seamstress who may be able to provide a chargeable service.

- 1 School tweed jacket
- 2 School tartan kilts
- 3 School V-neck jumpers
- 6 School cotton chambray blouses
- 2 Pairs black leather shoes, polishable (**not** boots, **not** suede, **not** mules), flat to medium heel
- 1 Coat which must be smart enough to look appropriate when covering a suit or blazer. Long enough to cover the blazer or jacket of a suit. Plain navy, black or charcoal grey - not puffas, anoraks, or with fur on hood.
- School scarf (optional)
- Black woollen gloves (optional)
- Tights in navy
- **For Boarders only:**
- 2 Pairs pyjamas
- 1 Dressing gown (essential)
- 1 Pair slippers
- 3 Medium sized bath towels (with loop half way down one of the long sides)
- Washing kit
- Casual clothes and underwear, all clearly marked

**Girls' Sixth Form (Years 12-13)** (School Colours do not supply Sixth Form dress).

- Name Tapes – as above.  
**All tapes should have House initials after student's name.**
- A classic tailored plain suit in black, charcoal grey or navy. Jacket length must be below hip level to cover any shirt/blouse/sweater worn, and can be worn with either skirt or trousers. Skirts should allow for easy movement and sit on or near the knee. Trousers, also cut to sit at waist, should be of a classic tailored fit and of an appropriate length for school footwear, not cropped. Stretch fabrics, linen or denim are not suitable. Subtle check or pinstripe is acceptable.
- White blouses/shirts with collar
- Black, brown or navy polishable shoes (**not** boots, **not** suede, **not** mules, flat to medium heels)
- Round or V-neck long sleeved jumpers, plain colour and finish of own choice, of sufficient length to cover the blouse/shirt (not cardigans)
- Sober coloured tights
- 1 Coat which must be smart enough to look appropriate when covering a suit or blazer. Long enough to cover the blazer or jacket of a suit. Plain navy, black or charcoal grey - not puffas, anoraks, or with fur on hood.

**Sixth Form attire can be purchased from any suitable outfitters but must be as described above. There are well-defined dress regulations. If in doubt about the acceptability of any item, please consult your Housemistress.**
