<input type="checkbox"/>	* 1 x Bath tartan kilt, mid calf length (Year 5 – 6)
<input type="checkbox"/>	* 1 x Bath tartan kilt or Senior tartan kilt, mid calf length (Year 7 – 8)
<input type="checkbox"/>	* 2 x V-necked navy blue jumpers with bottle trim
<input type="checkbox"/>	* 4 x cotton chambray revere blouses
<input type="checkbox"/>	6 pairs navy socks or navy cotton rich or opaque tights (60 denier or above) <i>available from the School Shop</i>
