



Gresham's School Sport Spectator Policy

We aim for all pupils to have the opportunity to be supported when representing the School, but we also need to ensure that the health and safety of pupils and staff remains paramount.

We use Government guidance and advice from the national governing bodies of individual sports to facilitate training and fixtures as safely as possible.

With effect from **Thursday 10th June 2021** spectators will be allowed on site to watch sport fixtures. Fixtures will be on the only co-curricular activity where spectators will be allowed, and this will be reviewed at the May half-term. The following guidelines must be observed –

- In line with current Government guidance, all participants (pupils, school staff, match officials, and spectators) should check for symptoms of Covid-19 before attendance. If an individual is symptomatic and/or living in a household with a possible or confirmed Covid-19 infection, they should remain at home and follow Government guidance.
- All spectators coming to the Senior School must park in the new car park by the Astro turf pitches.
- All visitors must sign in electronically using the NHS QR scanning point, located at the car park.
- At this stage we are only allowing **two adults per family on site as spectators**.
- Spectators should remain in their cars until the match commences and return to their cars at the end of the match.
- Social distancing must be adhered to at all times, and spectators should bring their own refreshments.
- Cricket spectators are asked to spread themselves around the boundary, Hockey spectators should distribute evenly around the Astro turf pitches and Tennis spectators around the outside of the tennis courts.
- Please do not leave the confines of the spectating areas, except to return to your vehicle.
- Toilets will remain closed for the foreseeable future.
- By signing in on match days you are agreeing to these guidelines and the policy document. Members of staff will monitor the situation and may politely remind you of the guidelines.

We look forward to welcoming parents at our fixtures this term and beyond. It is important for pupils, staff and parents that we return to normal as soon as possible but this must be done in a safe and sensible way.
