M E S S A G E F R O M T H E H E A D

Organising school uniform for your son or daughter is only one item on a long list of 'jobs to do' before the start of a new academic year, so I thought it might be helpful to bring to your attention some points to consider as far as uniform is concerned.

In a school of our size it really is vital that clothing is named. Any anxiety associated with the misplacing of a jumper that has been taken off somewhere around school or a sock which has been left in the changing room can be avoided if a name tape is sewn on. If you buy items from the Second-Hand Shop, please ensure that your child's name replaces the name already on the clothing.

The importance of naming games' kit cannot be underestimated; games staff, matrons and House staff all agree that lost and borrowed games kit is reduced significantly when kit is named. Therefore, we hope that you are happy to support the system we believe works effectively, which is outlined below:

Items of sports clothing should be named on the outside of the garment as explained in the uniform list. Name tapes can be ordered by email from Wovina at www.wovina.com. The turnaround is approximately seven days. (For further details, go into 'Labels and tags to buy online', then into 'Identification products'.) We use, as standard, 10mm name tapes for all school uniform and casual wear in this format – John Smith K. Games kit labels should be 12mm in the following format - J SMITH K. Name tapes come in packets of 72. On the website you need to find Style 6; this correct style for the school. All boys should have a K (which stands for Kenwyn) on their name tapes and all girls a C (which stands for Crossways).

This company also do sheets of stick-on labels that are great for shoes and stationery items!

Games kit should therefore be named, appropriately looped (as instructed on clothing list), and brought to school for the start of the Michaelmas Term 2021. A named kit check by sports staff and matrons will take place in the first week.

We hope you will agree that this measure should help in our endeavour to minimise the frustration and extra cost incurred when unnamed kit needs to be replaced.

HOW TO MEASURE SCHOOL UNIFORM

HEIGHT

Measure from the top of the head down to the ground - make sure the child is barefoot with their heels together and feet flat on the floor.

HIPS

Place the tape measure around the fullest part of the bottom.

HEIGHT

Take the tape through the arms and around the fullest part of the chest.

INSIDE LEG

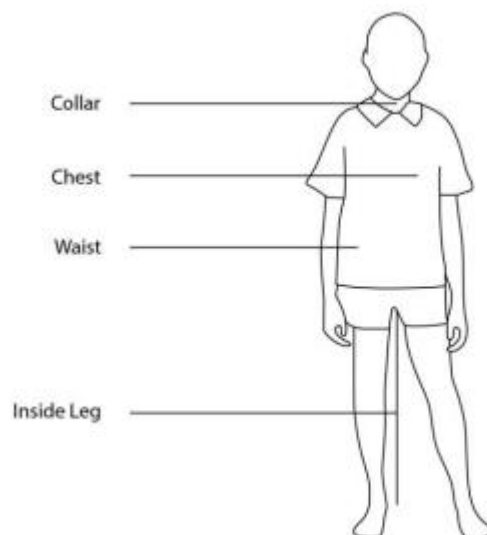
Measure with shoes on to approximately 5cm above the ground.

WAIST

Place the tape measure around the natural waistline, taking care not to pull it too tightly.

COLLAR

Place the tape measure around the base of the neck where the collar usually sits, again taking care not to pull the tape too tightly as it is important to have a little extra room around the neck.



SCHOOL SHOP

The Shop is situated within the School and is open during term time and during the last two weeks of the Summer Holiday.

All new and pre-loved school uniform and sports kit is available from the School Shop. We operate an appointment system for fittings, which take approximately one hour.

We request that new pupils, and especially families living overseas, book their appointments early as space is limited and your child is expected to start the new school term in uniform. If you are flying into the UK ahead of the beginning of term, we respectfully ask that you make an appointment to have your uniform fitting first. The School Shop is located at the Senior School (next to Farfield Boarding House). From Cromer Road follow the signs for Farfield and Auden Theatre.

Naming of Uniform

The shop offers a heat pressed name labelling service at a one-off charge of £90.00 per pupil. This covers all items of uniform to be named for the entire time that your child is at Gresham's School.

The School Shop also sells school and games socks with your child's name and house woven into each sock. Please email us to order these.

Please note that all items of uniform, equipment and other possessions brought into School must be clearly named. Boarders must have all home clothes named.

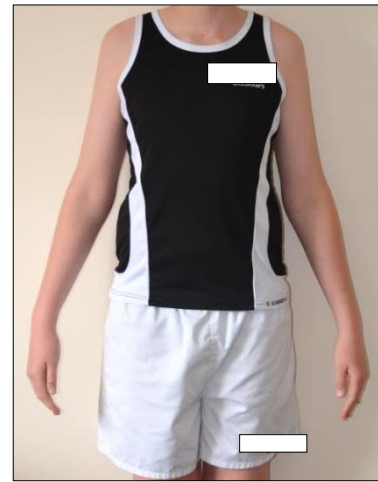
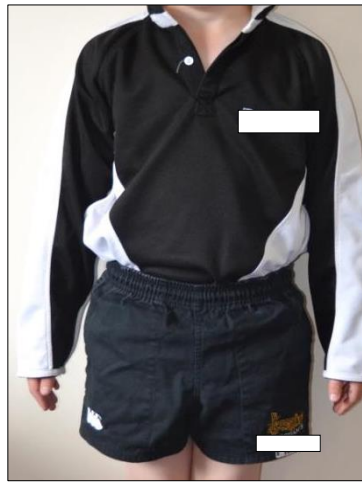
