



School Shop

The Shop is situated within the School and is open during term time and during the last two weeks of the Summer Holiday.

All new school uniform and sports kit is available from the School Shop. During the last two weeks of the Summer holiday we operate an appointment system for fittings, which take approximately one hour. During term time parents and pupils can come to the shop to purchase items within the opening hours listed below. We also offer a 'click and collect' service and requests should be emailed to shop@greshams.com.

During the Summer holiday, we request that new pupils, and especially families living overseas, book their appointments early as space is limited and your child is expected to start the new school term in uniform. If you are flying into the UK ahead of the beginning of term, we respectfully ask that you make an appointment to have your uniform fitting first. **Appointments will not be available on the Induction Day.** Please follow this link to book your fitting. <https://www.trybooking.co.uk/BNDA>

Naming of Uniform

The shop offers a heat pressed name labelling service at a one-off charge of £90.00 per pupil. This covers all items of uniform to be named (including socks and tights) for the entire time that your child is at Gresham's School.

The School Shop also sells school and games socks with your child's name and house woven into each sock. Please email us to order these.

Please note that all items of uniform, equipment and other possessions brought into School **must** be clearly named. Boarders **must** have all home clothes named.

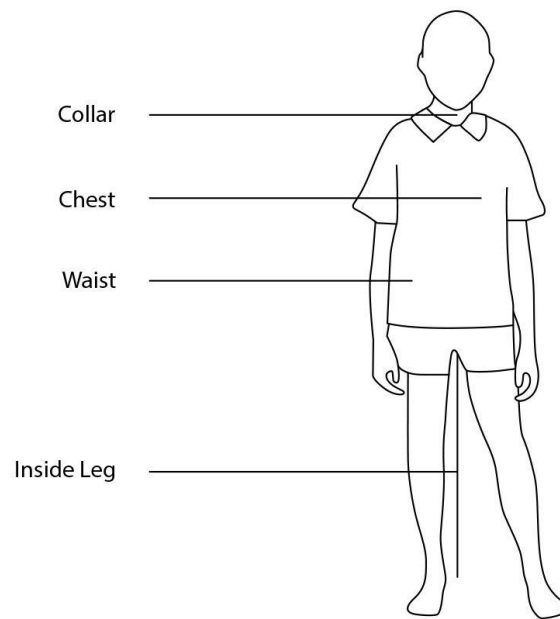

MEASUREMENT GUIDE



Height

Measure from the top of the head down to the ground - make sure the child is barefoot with their heels together and feet flat on the floor.

Hips

Place the tape measure around the fullest part of the bottom.

Chest

Take the tape through the arms and around the fullest part of the chest.

Inside leg

Measure with shoes on to approximately 5cm above the ground.

Waist

Place the tape measure around the natural waistline, taking care not to pull it too tightly.

Collar

Place the tape measure around the base of the neck where the collar usually sits, again taking care not to pull the tape too tightly as it is important to have a little extra room around the neck.
