ABOUT THE SCHOOL DAY

WHAT HAPPENS AT MORNING DROP OFF?

- 8.00 8.10 am: The school doors are open for children arriving at Breakfast Club. Please sign in at the gate; your child will be taken to the hall.
- 8.25 8.50 am: The school doors
 will be open. Please bring your child
 to their classroom. A sign in sheet
 will be available for you to write
 down home time information.

VISITING US DURING THE SCHOOL DAY

If you need to come into school during the school day, please make contact with the School Office via the intercom on the main gate entrance.

WHAT HAPPENS AT THE END OF THE SCHOOL DAY?

- The school day ends at 3.30pm for Nursery, Reception and Year 1 children and at 3.45pm for Year 2 children.
- After School Club is available for those parents unable to collect at the end of the school day. Available until 5.30pm Mon/Tue/Thu/Fri, and 5pm on a Wednesday.

CAN MY CHILD DO A HOBBY?

A range of after school hobbies are offered to children in Reception to Year 2. Hobbies run from 3.45 – 4.30pm.

Your hobby commitment lasts for the duration of a term, and may have limited spaces.

DAILY TIMETABLE

You will receive a copy of your child's timetable and Curriculum Newsletter at the start of each term which will give you a summary of what is covered in the term ahead.

These will also be displayed on the Parent Noticeboard by the classroom and on the Parent Portal.

CURRICULUM

Each year group will provide you with

a year-specific information booklet with details of the relevant curriculum.

We are so lucky to have **Specialist Teachers** from the Prep and Senior Schools who come to the Nursery & Pre-Prep to teach specialist subjects such as PE, music, dance & drama and modern foreign languages.

We also visit other parts of the school to make use of the fantastic facilities – from the swimming pool to the Auden Theatre, the Britten Building (music) and the Dyson Building (science, technology, engineering, art and maths).





OWLS - OUTDOOR WILD LEARNING SCHOOL

(incorporates Beach School)

All Nursery & Pre-Prep children attend regular outdoor learning sessions at the Senior School woods.

LIBRARY

All children visit the School Library and have the opportunity to take a book home. Books can be changed each week.

LEARNING ENRICHMENT

Learning Enrichment is available for all children during their time at Gresham's Pre-Prep. The need for support may be short-term, as a result of absence or a difficulty with a particular subject, a specific learning difficulty or simply a less conventional learning style. We are here to support every child.

In Learning Enrichment, we aim to preserve and develop our children's self-esteem and motivation by celebrating their strengths and abilities. Assistance is given to consolidate learning or provide an extra challenge for More Able, Gifted and Talented children.

The Learning Enrichment department operates with an "open door" policy for children, staff and parents.

FOOD AND DRINK

At Gresham's we promote the value of eating healthily together.

- Breakfast club Cereal and toast are offered to those children who attend.
- Morning Snack -The children have fresh fruit and vegetable sticks.
- Water bottles Please could your child have a named water bottle in school, which we will clean. This is filled with fresh water daily.
- Lunch Lunch takes place
 in the hall and is provided by
 Holroyd Howe Caterers. Catering
 supervisors serve the meals, aided
 by staff members. The meal begins
 with a simple grace. Staff sit with

the children and encourage good table manners. All children, except Nursery, collect their own meals and clear the tables at the end of meals. The weekly menu is displayed in the Pre-Prep entrance hall.

- Afternoon Snack A light snack is offered during the afternoon.
- After School Club A small sandwich is served for those who need to stay in school late.

Specific dietary requirements

Special dietary requirements are catered for i.e. vegetarians, milk allergies etc. Please ensure you notify the school office of any specific dietary requirements.

BIRTHDAYS

You are welcome to bring cakes in to celebrate a birthday. Please remember we are NUT FREE! If your child has a food intolerance, please provide us with some alternative treats that they can have rather than cake.

HAIR, NAILS & ACCESSORIES

Nursery & Pre-Prep children do not need to bring any stationery into school.





YOUR HOUSE AND HOW IT WORKS

Nursery & Pre-Prep Houses are named after local National Trust Houses; Blickling, Felbrigg and Oxburgh. All children from Ash Class (3-4 year olds) through to Year 2 are allocated to a House. Nursery & Pre-Prep siblings will be in the same House.

House points are awarded throughout each term and the House with the most points at the end of the school year receives a cup sporting the House Colours.



REWARDS

NURSERY & PRE-PREP GOLDEN RULES

Throughout the Nursery & Pre-Prep, children are taught to follow the school's 'Golden Rules'. The rules were agreed by the School Council. 'Be kind', 'Be honest' and 'Work hard'.

'Golden Time' is a reward for Reception to Year 2 children's good learning and behaviour throughout the week. Children can bring in a small toy from home on a Friday for Golden Time. No electronic toys permitted.

HOBBIES

Our hobbies (Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays) change termly and cover a vast range of activities – from craft to construction and 'superheroes' to football and tennis. Hobbies are available to all children in Reception to Year 2.

AFTER SCHOOL CLUB

After School Club (ASC) operates each day until 5.30pm (5pm on Wednesdays). Please note there is no ASC on Home Weekends or the last day of each half term/term.

All year groups have a termly trip to one of the huge range of venues available in Norfolk.

Visitors to the Nursery and Pre-Prep range from travelling theatre groups to 'Little City', an entirely mobile role play city.

EARLY YEARS FUNDING

(for 3 and 4 year old children)

Children in Nursery and Reception who are 3 and 4 years old are entitled to Early Years funding from the Government for 15 hours a week. We are not offering the extended 30 hours funding.

Further information can be found on the school website, www.greshams.com in the fees section. The Nursery & Pre-Prep Office will provide you with the relevant paperwork termly which enables the school to claim the funding.
