## **Allow me to introduce you to The Old Greshamian Golfing Society**

The key features of the Society are:

- Annual membership fees of £25 are payable by standing order on 1<sup>st</sup> September each year (no charge for those aged 26 and under)
- We have a membership of around 80 OG's, with abilities ranging from low single figure handicappers through to those who enjoy their golf but have no expectation of breaking 100 – we are an eclectic society and encourage participation from players of all abilities
- For the better golfers (good single figures) we enter teams in the two principal 'old pupils' tournaments. Firstly the Halford Hewitt comprising teams of 10 golfers from 64 schools played in foursomes knock-out format over Royal St Georges and Royal Cinque Ports in April each year. Secondly the Grafton Morrish, played by 32 teams of 6 players over Hunstanton and Brancaster in late September/early October. Scratch stableford qualifying events are held for this competition in May each year
- In addition, for the better golfers aged over 50, we enter a team of 6 in the Cyril Gray tournament, played at Worplesdon in late June every year
- For the wider membership we hold Spring, Summer and Autumn meetings, all played off handicap, generally within or around East Anglia – recent courses that we have played include Sheringham, Royal Worlington, Woodhall Spa, Aldeburgh, Hunstanton, Brancaster and Gog Magog
- We also try to have an annual match against the school Governors/Fishmongers at Brancaster, and are hoping to introduce a regular match against the school and the staff.
- We have just confirmed the addition of a match against the Old Haileyburians and we plan to include matches against other schools' old boy societies
